


Reception - Remote Teaching and Learning Guidance

What will Remote Teaching and Learning look like for my child/children?

In Reception your child's assignments will be posted on Seesaw between **8.00 am and 8.30am**. This will be a phonics, maths and review activity daily, guided reading and writing tasks for the week and other wider curriculum activities throughout the week. We will also read stories regularly throughout the week. In Early Years, the children learn through play. Please spend time daily playing with your child, talking with them and joining in with their games. I would love to see pictures of this and the children can write about this during their end of day 'Review'!

Please also let me know if you have taken part with any other lessons such as the Oak Academy lessons or BBC TV lessons.



These learning tasks will mostly use slides or video instructions - the adult can respond on their behalf by either typing their response, taking a picture or video or voice recording.

In class we spend about **15 minutes** on a task.

Each activity will include instructions from the teacher either via video, voice instructions or written instructions.

The children **must** complete all of the tasks set on Seesaw and submit their responses through comments, photos, videos or voice messages. Once the responses have been submitted, the class teachers will provide feedback on the learning completed and often a step to challenge the learning further.

Each morning please check their Seesaw, and complete all of the learning challenges provided at a time in the day that suits you. If they need help, grown ups can send teachers a message via the family app, comment on the post or you can call school and your child's class teacher will call you back.

Children will also be given access to the app 'Reading Eggs' and 'Fast Phonics' to practise their reading and phonics skills. These are games for the children to play based on phonics and reading. Login's will be sent out to each family to use as you wish.

A weekly Timetable will be posted on Seesaw every Monday - which will include an overview of the week. This will allow children to prepare for the challenges in advance and you can begin to discuss their learning with them to help them.
