What will Remote Teaching and Learning look like for my child/children?

In year 3 your child's assignments will be posted on Google Classroom between 8:00am and 8.30 am. Your child's activities for the day will come with instructions on what is required. See the screenshot below for an example.

Every day will include an English, Maths and a wider curriculum challenge. Where maths slides have answer boxes, please insert a text box to write the answer. It is important that your child then clicks on share to send them back to me so I can provide feedback. Green highlighting means have another try!

The children must complete all of the tasks within the assignment and then press the 'hand in/turn in' button.

Each morning, children should check their Google Classroom, read the instructions and complete all of the learning challenges provided. If they are stuck, they can ask within the comment section of the assignment post. Comments should only relate to learning and should not be used as a way of pupils sending greetings to each other. Activities will also be posted on Seesaw.

Through Symbaloo children can access lots of apps, try to go on at least 2 each day. These include Reading Eggs, Mymaths, Mathletics, Spellzone, Epic reading, TT Rockstars, Numbots, Number Gym. All usernames and passwords have been sent home. Please ask if you need another copy of these.

Every Monday I will be posting a weekly check in sheet in Google Classroom which your child will be able to edit to say how they are feeling. This is a really good way for us all to stay connected.

A weekly Timetable will be posted on Google Classroom every Monday - which will include an overview of the week. This will allow children to prepare for the challenges in advance and begin to do some independent research.
