Staying Safe within the Community and online

We would like to bring your attention to some concerning news that could compromise your child's safety. We have been made aware that there are increasingly alarming incidents of anti-social behaviour happening out of school hours on and around the Fairy Trail near the Foss Trail. The Fairy Trail itself is being destroyed by groups of young children and mopeds and bikes are being set on fire. First and foremost, it is incredibly dangerous and we do not want to imagine how hurt someone could get.

Secondly, the Police are looking to set up cameras in the hope of catching whoever is doing this. We have spoken to the children but please can we ask that you do the same and if you know your child has been playing in that area that it may be a good idea for them to avoid the area unless supervised by an adult.

The police are also aware of children using social media sites to send inappropriate videos and messages as well as using it to bully other children. Any form of bullying in person or on social media will not be tolerated. We encourage parents/guardians to familiarise yourself with the age limits attached to all social media and ask that you speak to your child about using these in a safe and sensible manner.

We hope you will support the school and the police by helping to take a stand against bullying and anti-social behaviour.
