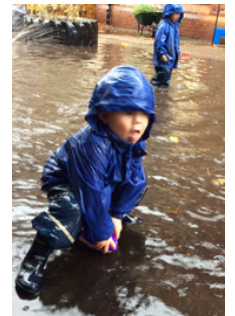


A message from Mrs Robinson
