#### A message from Mrs Robinson

Dear Families,

This week all of our Year 1 children completed their Phonics Screening Assessment. The children were absolutely fantastic and really showed off all of their learning. We will inform parents and carers of the pass mark on the end of year reports. All of our Year 4 children have completed the standard multiplication test over the last 2 weeks. The children had to answer 25 questions on multiplication calculations up to 12x12 - the difficulty being they only had 6 seconds to answer each question. The children were great and took the test in their stride. We would like to say thank you to all of our families for supporting their children with their phonics and multiplication at home.

Your child's school report will be sent home with your child before the end of term. This report will include your child's academic achievements, general progress and attendance. The Year 4 Multiplication Checks will be included in the Year 4 reports and Key Stage 2 SATs results will be included in the Year 6 pupil reports.


