Haxby Road Price Increases September 2023

With the continual challenges we are facing in terms of inflation and energy and to ensure a sustainable and nutritious meal is provided to the children, our school meal provider has found it necessary to agree a price increase in relation to the Primary School meal. However, as a school we are subsidising this and school will be paying a portion of this cost.

New Price £2.75

We last increased the Breakfast and After School Club prices in 2018

We are always sensitive to any costs that our families incur and we never like to increase prices however we must also balance this with the pressures of the school budget. Of course, over the last two years there has been an increase in wages, pension and food and energy costs which now need to be factored in.

Breakfast Club will increase to £3.50 a session After School Club to £7.00 a session.

We believe that this is still good value for the childcare provided. I hope that you are able to continue to benefit from these clubs and can support us in this decision.


