Our successful Golden Party will continue this half term. All children with attendance above 97% will be invited to the party.

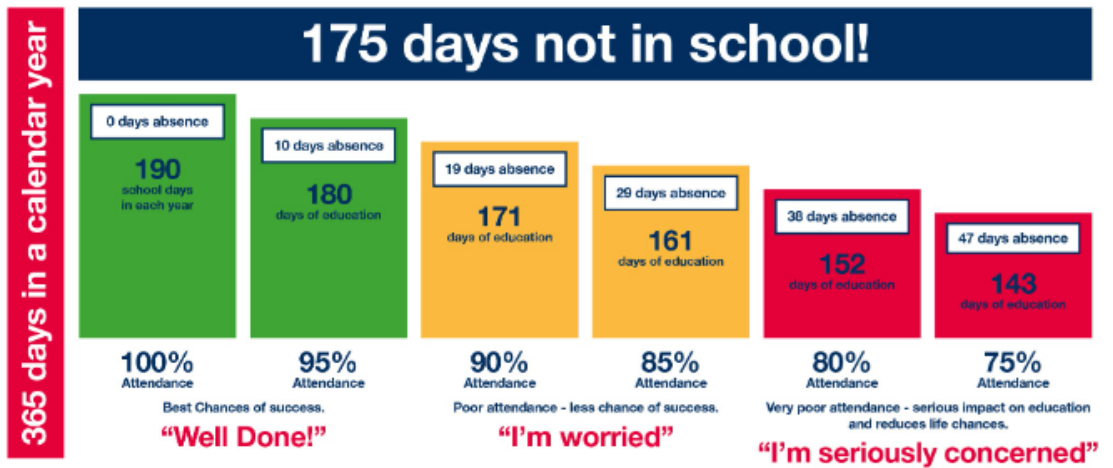
Thank you for your ongoing support with attendance. We know that you recognise that attending school daily and on time has a positive impact on learning, progress and therefore the best life chances for your child's success.

Lines of Communication 2023-24

In order to ensure parental queries are addressed promptly, we would like to clarify lines of communication within school. If you have a query related to your child, in the first instance this should be communicated to your child's class teacher. This can be through Seesaw or a conversation with them after school.

The class teacher knows your child best and is the one who spends every day with them in class. If your query is not resolved, or you are concerned about the outcome, your query should then be taken to your child's Key Stage Assistant Headteacher:

Early Years and Key Stage 1: Mrs Eddon
Key Stage 2 (year group 3,4,5 and 6): Mr Hind

The next step after speaking to the assistant headteacher is to speak to Mrs Robinson (Headteacher). If our child attends the Enhanced Resource Provision please contact Mrs Battersby (Head of ERP) for any concerns.
